Coronavirus notice from the City of Rochester

The City of Rochester is taking continuous action to aid in preventing any spread of the coronavirus at the City Government level. As the Federal and State Governments continue to make policy changes and implement new measures, we will also continue to evolve. Again, we will reiterate the importance of being diligent and not panic. The Fulton County Health Department is the lead organization for our community and we are working closely with them on this event.

As the previous release stated, all non-essential City meetings have been canceled for 30 days and all non-city meetings utilizing city facilities have been canceled/postponed for 30 days. In addition to these measures the City of Rochester has issued the following directives:

- 1. City Summer Parks Program for this summer has been canceled.**
- 2. City Pool opening will be delayed.**
- 3. Rochester Water and Wastewater utilities will suspend any penalties for non-payment for 60 days.**
- 4. Rochester Water and Wastewater utilities will suspend any shut-offs for 60 days. This, however, does not negate the payment of the bill. You may contact the utility office to make payment arrangements, 574-223-3412 or email them at wateroffice@rochester.in.us**
